DANCE PARTICIPATION

Students are to conduct themselves as mature, responsible individuals. Obedience to chaperones and school officials is expect ed at all times. Undesirable or improper conduct of a student at a school sponsored event results in the loss of student activities, notification of parents/gu ardians, and/or disciplinary action by administration.

You may not return to your car while the dance is in session unless you are leaving with permission.

You may not return to the dance without permission once you leave.

Please respect God and others by dancing appropriately.

DRESS CODE

Girls

- · Casual, semi-formal, or costume
- No low cut dresses, in the front. No bare midriff, sides, or stomach showing. Back should be mostly covered.
- Dress length reaches the bottom of the fingertips when arms are fully extended (minimum).
- If there are slits on the dress, they are to run no higher than the bottom of the fingertips when arms are fully extended.
- What we are looking for is modesty. If it is questionable, get it approved first. The rules <u>will</u> be enforced. Failure to obey will result in <u>not</u> being admitted to the dance or expulsion from the dance.

Boys

- · Casual, semi-formal, or costume
- No jeans for formal or semi-formal events
- The rules will be enforced. Failure to obey will result in not being admitted to the dance or expulsion from the dance.

DANCE ATTENDANCE ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Students must be in official school attendance (attend minimum of 50% of classes) on the scheduled day of the dance if the dance is on a school day.
- 2. Guests assigned suspension on the day of or day before the dance shall not attend the dance.
- 3. All school policies are in effect during dances *including the dress policy* (unless specifically noted by administration). Provocative clothing are not permitted. Students disciplined for failure to abide by such policies may be denied attendance at future dances.
- 4. Gum chewing is not permitted at school dances. (This is due to respect for the facility and as per many of their requirements.)
- 5. Suggestive or provocative dancing is strictly prohibited. Such dancing <u>will</u> result in discipline and removal from the dance and attendance <u>at future dances</u>.
- 6. Faculty and administration has sole authority in enforcing dance regulations.
- 7. Students shall be picked up no later than 15 minutes (unless helping with tear down) following the conclusion of the dance. Attendance at future dances may be jeopardized if this policy is ignored.
