#### EAGLES ADVENTURE CAMP 2024 INFORMATION

<u>CAMP DATES</u> - Camp begins *Monday*, *June 10*<sup>th</sup> and ends on *Friday*, *August 2*<sup>nd</sup>.

<u>CAMP HOURS</u> – Camp will begin at 8:00 am and will dismiss at 4:00 pm. Students can be checked in at 7:45 am through the elementary school office without being charged for extended care.

EXTENDED CARE – Extended care opens at 6:30 am and closes at 6:00 pm. Students must be signed in for before-school care and signed out of after-school care by a parent or other authorized person (must present identification at check-out area in the afternoon), helping us maintain a high level of security. (Payments are to be made as often as necessary to keep account current. A late fee of \$20 will be charged to any account which is 10 days past due)

<u>STUDENT DROP-OFF</u> – Students should be walked in by a parent or other authorized person and signed in through the Elementary School Office. Parents or authorized persons dropping off students are encouraged to park in the North parking lot near the Elementary School Office. Parents dropping students off and picking students up will enter and exit the campus from the west end of the campus through the ALFC Administration Building driveway off of Red Oak or the northeast gate near the hospital. <u>Parents are not permitted to park in front of the ALFC Administration Building.</u>

<u>STUDENT PICK-UP</u> –Students will remain in their classroom until 4:15 pm (15 minutes after dismissal time). Students not picked up by 4:15 pm, will be automatically checked into extended care. Parents or authorized persons picking up students will check out students through the Elementary School Office. Parents picking up students will enter and exit the campus from the west end of the campus through the ALFC Administration Building driveway off of Red Oak or the northeast gate near the hospital. <u>Parents are not permitted to park in front of the ALFC Administration Building.</u>

<u>EMERGENCY / PICK-UP / EMAIL INFORMATION</u> – Each family should go into **Camp Brain** and complete your home/mailing address, email address for both parents, home and cell phone numbers for parents, as well as all the emergency contact information in case of an emergency. Please try to include as many emergency contacts as possible.

**<u>COMMUNICATIONS</u>** - UCA will be using **Camp Brain** to communicate with you this summer camp. Please make sure you check your inbox for any daily updates, camper communications, and/or schedule adjustments.

<u>DAILY CAMP ATTIRE</u> – Please take time to carefully review the required camp attire document, as it will be strictly enforced beginning the first day of camp. Parents are expected to make sure that their children are dressed in accordance with the camp dress code and not deviate from it. Students who are not properly dressed will not be admitted to class and must be brought camp-approved attire from home or picked up by a parent. Subsequent dress code violations will result in further consequences.

<u>BREAKFAST & HOT LUNCH</u> – Progressive Catering for Schools is our campus food provider. Lunch meals will be available to be PRE-ORDERED online through our new lunch ordering system, **Meal Magic**. Lunch ordering procedures will be posted via **ParentSquare** and **Camp Brain**. The price for lunch is \$6.00 per day. If your child needs an emergency lunch it will be \$8.00 and you will be billed to your child's account

**WATER DAYS-** Girls are only allowed to wear one piece bathing suits, no two-piece suits and no tankini suites. All 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade girls are required to wear shorts over their bathing suites. Incoming 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade boys are required to wear a t-shirt/rash guard with their trunks. Shoes must be worn at all times, water shoes are encouraged. For safety reasons absolutely no bare feet or flip flops will be allowed. Parents should apply sunscreen on their camper before checking them in, camper may re-apply on self only for health precautions camper may not share.

<u>CAMP SUPPLIES</u> – Please make sure your child comes prepared each day of camp with a hydro flask filled with water, and a beach towel with their name on it. Additional supplies will be required based on camp activities; parents will be notified in advance.

**NO ELCTRONIC DEVICES-** Students are not allowed to bring iPad, iPod, iPhone watches, cellphones, tablets, laptops or gaming devices to camp.

<u>MEDICATION</u> – All medication including over the counter medication, and sunscreen, requires a Doctors Authorization Form to administer. Authorization forms to administer medication on campus and any additional forms are available in the elementary office. #### EAGLES ADVENTURE CAMP ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

At UC Eagles Adventure Camp, we agree that our appearance, inside and out, is a reflection of God in our lives to those we encounter. Dress and grooming at United Christian Academy should be characterized by neatness, modesty, and moderation. The purpose of appropriate dress is to show honor to others, focus on the heart, and not regard dress as simply a matter of individual expression. As such, we require students to follow these policies, and for families to support them.

In all issues of school dress, UC Eagles Adventure Camp reserves the right to determine what is immodest, immoderate, extreme, or otherwise unacceptable in clothing and hairstyle. Students who are not properly dressed will not be admitted to class and must be brought a change of clothing from home or picked up by a parent.

#### **Tops**

The bottom styles allowed are:

Jumper (Girls) Skort (Girls) Skirt (Girls) Shorts (Boy or Girl styles) Pants (Boy or Girl styles)

#### **Bottoms**

The bottom styles allowed are: Jumper, skort, skirt, shorts, pants (Girls) Shorts or pants (Boy)

#### Shoes

All shoes must have a flat heel and closed heel and toe. Students may wear water shoes on water days. No sandals or flip flops are permitted.

Dress Code Violation will be imposed if dress code is not followed. Parent / Guardian will be responsible for any adjustments needed.

#### **Field Trip Attire**

Field Trip attire will be at the director's discretion, depending on the type of trip they are taking. Unless the director specifies a different dress for that day, the students must wear their camp shirt on field trips.

#### Theme/Free Dress Up Days

There will be opportunities for students to have "theme dress up days". These days will be communicated in advance.

#### Hair

Girls – Hair must be neat and not draw undue attention to the individual; the hair must be kept out of the eyes (may not fall below eyebrows). Unnatural hair color or hairstyles will not be allowed.


Boys – Hair must be neat and well-groomed and should not impair vision. The length of the hair may not be longer than the top of the collar (use regular collared shirt as guideline), cover more than half of the ear, or fall below the eyebrows. The hairstyle must not draw undue attention to the individual (e.g., mohawks, faux-hawks, tails, spikes, etc.).


Certain exceptions may be made for cultural and religious considerations. All such exceptions must be requested in writing to school Administration and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
